1. Travel and Arrival	
Where should I go when I arrive?	Please arrive at the New Place entrance from 6pm, talk will start at 6.30pm.
What is the address of Shakespeare's New Place?	22 Chapel St, Stratford-upon-Avon CV37 6EP
Is there parking at the venue?	No, but there are a number of pay and display car parks in Stratford-upon-Avon town centre, as well as a Park & Ride, signposted from the A46, which offers an easy, relaxing and great value journey into Stratford-upon-Avon town centre 7 days a week this summer.
Where is the nearest train station?	Stratford-upon-Avon train station is on Station Road, CV37 6PL

Is the event held inside a building or outside?	The event will be inside and includes access to <i>The Women Who Made</i> Shakespeare exhibition
Is the venue wheelchair accessible?	Yes
Are there accessible toilets at the venue?	Yes
