

## Learning Outcomes

- Learn how language is a fluid and developing historical construct and that they are not alone in finding Shakespeare's language creative and unexpected.
- Gain confidence with increasingly challenging texts by learning new vocabulary, relating it explicitly to known vocabulary and understanding it with the help of context.
- Gain experience at making inferences and referring to evidence in the text.
- Will explore words and phrases that Shakespeare coined and think about how the language they are familiar with is also filled with new words.
- Will learn how literature can influence language.
