1. Travel and Arrival	
Where should I go when I arrive?	Please arrive at the Anne Hathaway's Cottage entrance from 8:30pm for a hot drink before the walk. The walk will start at 9.15pm.
What is the address of Anne Hathaways Cottage?	22 Cottage Ln, Shottery, Stratford-upon-Avon CV37 9HH

Is there parking at the venue?	There is a pay and display car park a short walk from Anne Hathaway's Cottage, in Cottage Lane, Shottery, CV37 9HH.
Where is the nearest train station?	Stratford-upon-Avon train station is on Station Road, CV37 6PL

2. The Venue	
Is the event held inside a building or outside?	The event will be held outside throughout. Gazebos will be provided for cover during refreshments but we recommend visitors dress appropriately for the weather.
Is the venue wheelchair accessible?	Due to the nature of this event we will be exploring mown pathways which may be uneven and difficult to navigate in a wheelchair, especially in wet weather. If you are planning to attend in a wheelchair we recommend contacting us in advance to discuss access in more detail.
