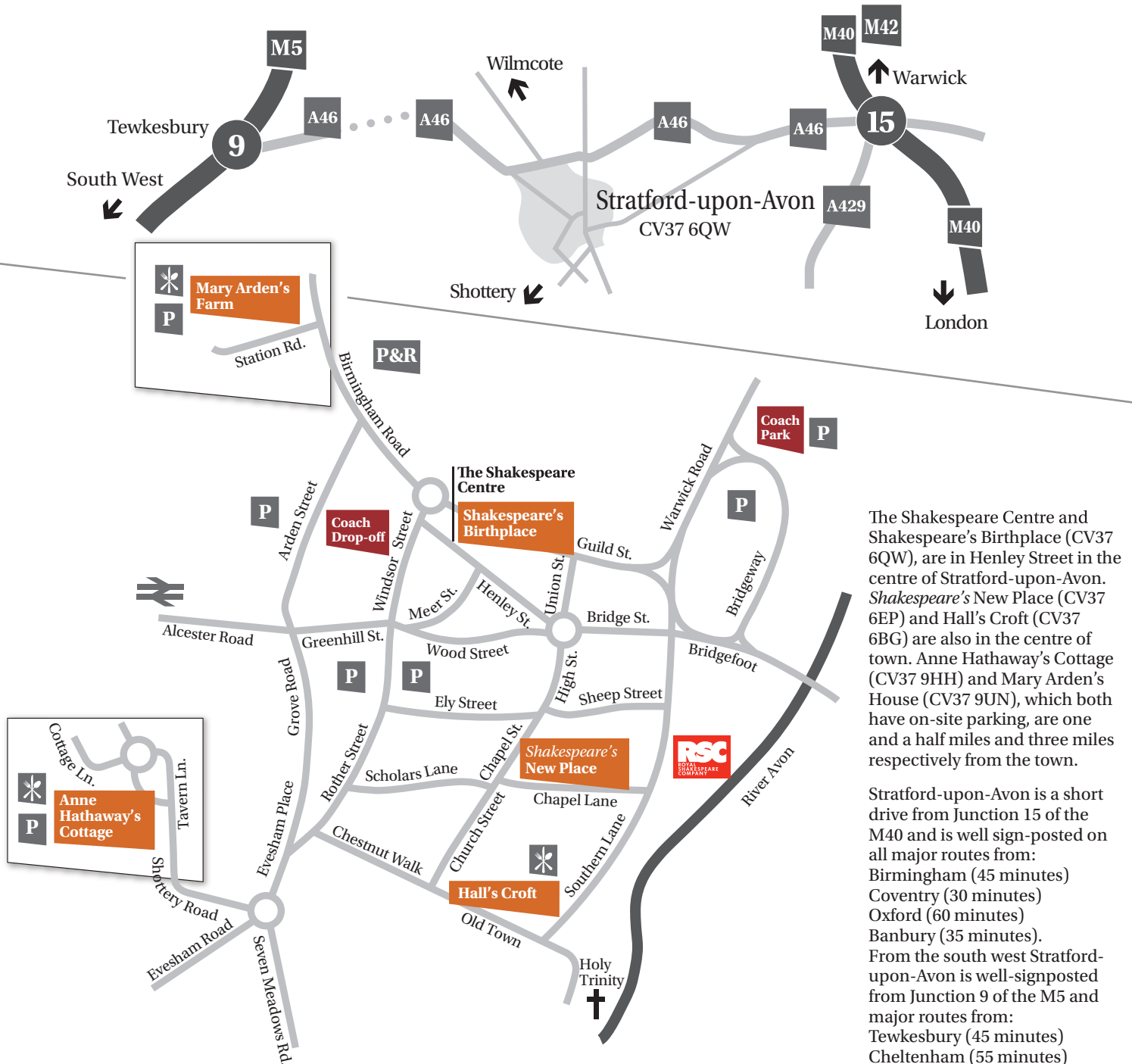


How to find us



The Shakespeare Centre and Shakespeare's Birthplace (CV37 6QW), are in Henley Street in the centre of Stratford-upon-Avon. *Shakespeare's New Place* (CV37 6EP) and Hall's Croft (CV37 6BG) are also in the centre of town. Anne Hathaway's Cottage (CV37 9HH) and Mary Arden's House (CV37 9UN), which both have on-site parking, are one and a half miles and three miles respectively from the town.

Stratford-upon-Avon is a short drive from Junction 15 of the M40 and is well sign-posted on all major routes from:

- Birmingham (45 minutes)
- Coventry (30 minutes)
- Oxford (60 minutes)
- Banbury (35 minutes).

From the south west Stratford-upon-Avon is well-signposted from Junction 9 of the M5 and major routes from:

- Tewkesbury (45 minutes)
- Cheltenham (55 minutes)
- Evesham (25 minutes)
- Worcester (40 minutes).
